Dear Member of the European Parliament,

With the beginning of a new mandate, the American Chamber of Commerce to the EU (AmCham EU) looks forward to working with the European Parliament in its efforts to secure a bright and prosperous future for EU citizens.

As a Brussels-based organisation, AmCham EU speaks for more than 150 American companies committed to Europe on trade, investment and competitiveness issues. We aim to ensure a growth-orientated business and investment climate in Europe. AmCham EU facilitates the resolution of transatlantic issues that impact business and plays a role in creating better understanding of EU and US positions on business matters. Aggregate US investment in Europe totalled more than €3.7 trillion in 2022, directly supports more than 4.9 million jobs in Europe and generates billions of euros annually in income, trade and research and development.

In the context of today's European and global challenges, AmCham EU has identified three key priorities that should drive the political agenda over the next five years in our recent vision document, [Attractiveness of Europe: Agenda for Action 2024-2029](#).
