Key findings



89% of respondents expect the transatlantic trade and investment relationship to worsen.



A majority of companies have a pessimistic outlook on how potential policy changes on both sides of the Atlantic will affect their European operations.



Europe is critical to the global operations of American companies, with 75% describing the region as 'extremely' or 'very' important.



Reducing trade barriers and regulatory burden highlighted as key areas for policymakers to address.





About this survey

As new administrations take office on both sides of the Atlantic, the American Chamber of Commerce to the European Union (AmCham EU) surveyed its members to find out how they expect political change to affect the transatlantic economic relationship.












How do you anticipate the policies of the new EU administration will impact your company's operations in Europe over the coming years?



How do you anticipate the policies of the new US administration will impact your company's operations in Europe over the coming years?















How important is the transatlantic relationship to your company's global success (eg, economic stability, security, supply chain integration and regulatory alignment)?



How important is Europe to your company's global operations (eg, revenue, market share, workforce and profitability)?













What actions would you recommend the EU and US take to reinforce their shared economic leadership globally?












To what extent is your company committed to playing a role in Ukraine's future economic prosperity and reconstruction?
